All sessions will be held in the Sunday School Classroom Area.

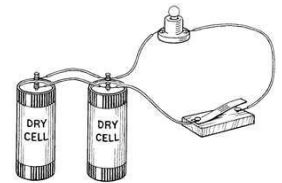
**Community Suppers held on April 11<sup>th</sup>, and May 9<sup>th</sup> starting at 4:30.**
