A letter of application must be sent from the student describing her academic and career plans, her need and qualifications for the scholarship, and her experiences as a Catholic woman. This letter should be 250 words or less and sent to the CDA c/o St. Peter the Apostle Church, 208 S. 4th Street, Oakland, MD. The scholarship is available to all Garrett County Catholic Women graduating from high school or returning to college.
